Terms & Conditions

Any semen imported into the UK from abroad, whether chilled or frozen, must be accompanied by the relevant health documents and an Intra Trade Certificate. These documents must be enclosed in the consignment. Owners, must be aware that any semen arriving without the necessary health documents, cannot be inseminated and therefore, your mare will miss that cycle even though you may still be charged for collection & shipping. Please ensure you inform the Stallion owner that these health papers are required to accompany the semen and clearly stating CEM & EVA status of the stallion with the stud vets signature.

- All mares will be wormed on arrival at stud and charged to the owner.
- A negative CEM Certificate must accompany the mare to stud.
- Mares will not be accepted at stud without a passport or identity document.
- It is requested that mares be sent UNSHOD
- Any extra's (Blacksmith, Vet, Wormers etc.) other than keep charges will be added to owners account.
- Should Veterinary Assistance be deemed necessary by ourselves, either in an emergency or to facilitate a pregnancy, the vet will be called and all costs will be paid by the mare owner direct to the veterinary surgeons, under their terms and conditions.
- It is requested that all mares are vaccinated for flu before arriving at stud, so as not to conflict with Insemination.
- Mares whilst at stud will receive every possible care, attention and supervision, but no responsibility can be taken for accident, theft, or disease. Stanley Grange Stud strongly advises that all animals should be Fully Comprehensively Insured whilst at stud.
- All mares are scanned/served/inseminated at their owners risk and Stanley Grange Stud accepts No Responsibility for injury, damage or loss caused through any of these procedures.
- All mares will be stabled at a charge of £175.00 per week. Due to out of hour scans etc. it is not possible to have grass keep.
- Stanley Grange Stud cannot be held responsible for the Non delivery, quality or delay of semen.
- All costs of semen, transport, flights, vet packages, couriers and equitainers are the responsibility of the mare owner.
- All accounts must be paid in full on collection of mare. All cheques to be made payable to Stanley Grange Stud.
- Mares are able to leave the stud after 28 days heartbeat scan. If the mare is removed before the final heartbeat scan it is the responsibility of the owner to arrange to have the mare scanned at home.
